### Fairview Physician Helps Redesign Surgical Component

Fairview orthopaedic surgeon Gordon I. Groh, MD was one of a team of four physicians who redesigned a component for a prosthesis used in shoulder replacement surgery. Called the RSP Monoblock, the new design allows for the use of reverse shoulder arthroplasty in the treatment of fractures, a procedure that will greatly increase the number of patients who can be treated with this surgical system.



In addition to research and maintaining his practice at Blue Ridge Bone & Joint in Asheville and Hendersonville, Dr. Groh spends significant time teaching and has presented in every major city in the U.S., as well as in Mexico, Canada and Japan.
